

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR EPWP WORK OPPORTUNITIES

The City of Cape Town has made it easier for you to register for the Jobseeker Database which is used for Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) opportunities. You can do it online anytime, see >>>> (requested short URL to follow shortly from Digital Communication).

EPWP is a national programme which has been implemented by the City of Cape Town since 2004. There are many different projects every year which recruit EPWP workers for temporary work opportunities, across a range of sectors: infrastructure, social, environment and culture. EPWP has targets for youth (18-35 years), differently enabled persons and women.

To ensure that the most appropriate work opportunities can be assigned to jobseekers, the Jobseekers Database requires all applicants to provide the following information about themselves, and to also update this every year:

- Personal identification (ID) information
- Residential address information
- Household & contact information
- Employment Equity information
- Education & skills information





Please make sure that you have the following documentation ready before registering, as these documents will have to be uploaded with your application.

Document	
	Certified copy of your ID or Passport
	Must be a good quality copy with a clear image. Does not need to be recently certified.
	Recent proof of residential address
	Dated within the past 3 months e.g. utility bill, bank statement or a copy of a signed confirmation letter from the Subcouncil you live in.
	CV or Resume (optional)
	Must be an updated CV/ Resume uploaded. If previous EPWP work was done, it should be noted in your CV/Resume.
