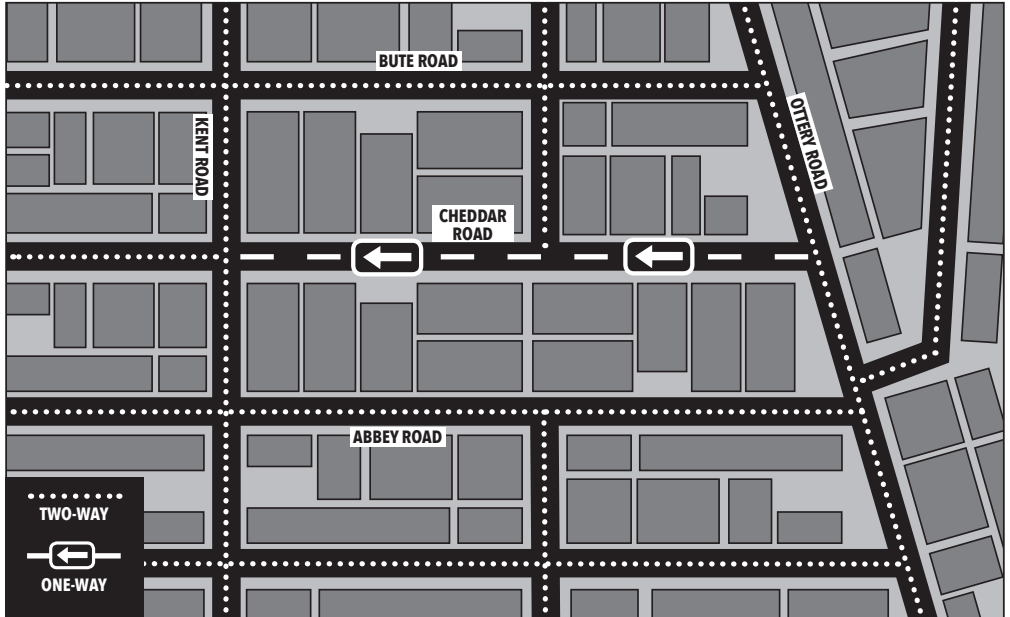




HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED ONE-WAY ROAD CONVERSION OF CHEDDAR ROAD, WYNBERG

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate invites residents, parents, and road users to comment on a proposal to introduce a permanent one-way system along Cheddar Road between Ottery Road and Kent Road in Wynberg. This proposal is designed to improve traffic flow, enhance safety, and create a more organised road environment around Wynberg High School. An area with many vulnerable road users during busy drop-off and pick-up times. By participating in this process, your insights and feedback can help shape a safer, more efficient neighbourhood for everyone.

Please refer to the area map to note the proposed permanent one-way road conversion of Cheddar Road from Ottery Road towards Kent Road.

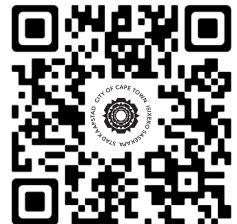
