

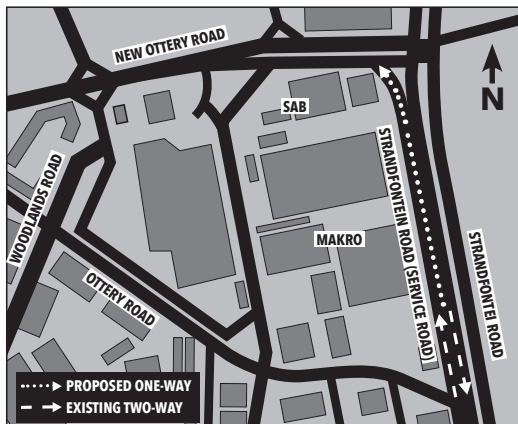


HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED ONE-WAY ROAD CONVERSION OF STRANDFONTEIN ROAD (SERVICE ROAD), OTTERY

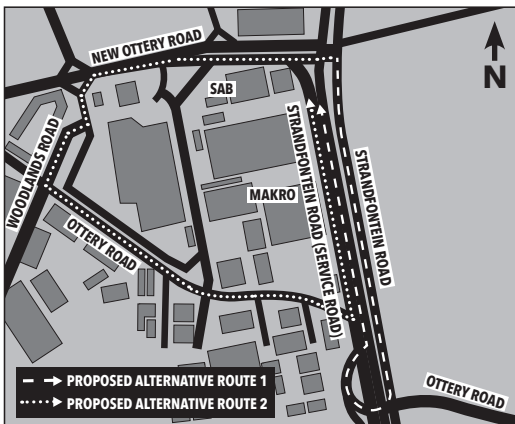
The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate invites residents and road users to comment on a proposal to introduce a permanent one-way system along a portion of Strandfontein Road (service road) between New Ottery Road and Ottery Road in Ottery. This proposal is designed to improve traffic flow between the Makro access and New Ottery Road. By participating in this process, your insights and feedback can help shape a safer, more efficient road for everyone.

The proposal includes:

- Permanently convert a portion of Strandfontein Road (service road), between the Makro access and New Ottery Road into a one-way roadway (in the northbound direction) as shown in Map 1.
- Due to the proposal, entry from New Ottery Road will be prohibited and traffic will have to re-route by two alternate routes as shown in Map 2.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input on the proposal to the municipality from 3 August to 4 September 2026.
