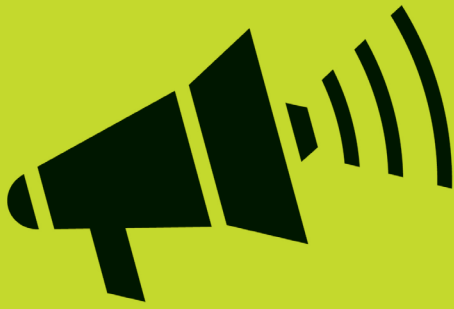




PUBLIC NOTICE: ROADWORKS IN BROOKLYN

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of roadworks in Brooklyn along Kings Road, Wren Street, Alwin Street, Kalmah Street, Corah Street, Van der Stel Avenue and Fenwick Street. This forms part of regular maintenance to prolong the longevity of the city's road network.

The work is planned to take place from Thursday 17 September 2026 until Saturday 14 November 2026 between 08:00 and 17:00, Monday to Saturday, weather permitting. Residents and road users can expect some noise and temporary traffic disruptions during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: PADWERKE IN BROOKLYN

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel die publiek hiermee in kennis van padwerke in Brooklyn in Kingsweg, Wrenstraat, Alwinstraat, Kalmahstraat, Corahstraat, Van der Stellaan en Fenwickstraat. Dit vorm deel van gereelde instandhouding om die lewensduur van die stad se padnetwerk te verleng.

Die werk sal na beplanning vanaf Donderdag 17 September 2026 tot Saterdag 14 November 2026 tussen 08:00 en 17:00, Maandag tot Saterdag, plaasvind, mits die weer dit toelaat. Inwoners en padgebruikers kan gedurende hierdie tyd 'n mate van geraas en tydelike verkeersontwrigtings verwag.

Let asseblief daarop dat:

- Die bogenoemde datums weens onvoorsiene omstandighede kan verander
- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaaië rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

Padgebruikers word aangemoedig om:

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerke in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak

Daar kan druk verkeer wees, en dus word padgebruikers aangeraai om alternatiewe roetes te oorweeg.
