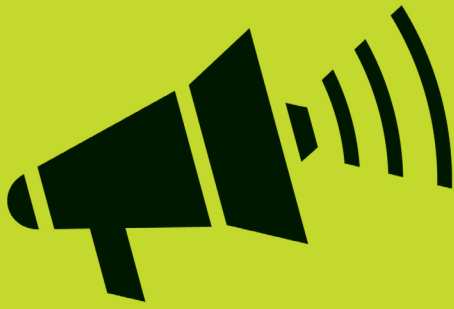




PUBLIC NOTICE: ROADWORKS IN PELICAN PARK

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of the construction of pedestrian sidewalks in Pelican Park along Old Strandfontein Road, Lorikeet Street, Roadrunner Street, Weaver Street, Starling Street, Tinkerbird Street, Lark Street, Flycatcher Road, Caracara Street, Seednipe Road and Woodswallow Street. The work forms part of the City's ongoing efforts to improve pedestrian infrastructure and safety.

The work is planned to take place from Monday 3 August 2026 until Friday 2 October 2026 between 07:30 and 17:00, Monday to Friday. Residents and business owners can expect some noise during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: PADWERKE IN PELICAN PARK

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel hiermee die publiek in kennis van die konstruksie van voetgangersypaadjies in Pelican Park langs Ou Strandfonteinweg, Lorikeetstraat, Roadrunnerstraat, Weaverstraat, Starlingstraat, Tinkerbirdstraat, Larkstraat, Flycatcherweg, Caracarastraat, Seednipeweg en Woodswallowstraat. Die werk vorm deel van die Stad se voorgesette pogings om voetgangerinfrastruktuur en -veiligheid te verbeter.

Volgens beplanning sal die werk van Maandag 3 Augustus 2026 tot Vrydag 2 Oktober 2026 tussen 07:30 en 17:00 van Maandag tot Vrydag gedoen word. Inwoners en besigheidseienaars kan geraas gedurende hierdie tydperk te wagte wees.

- Die bogenoemde datums weens onvoorsiene omstandighede kan verander
- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaaie rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

Padgebruikers word aangemoedig om:

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerke in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak

Daar kan druk verkeer wees, en dus word padgebruikers aangeraai om alternatiewe roetes te oorweeg.
