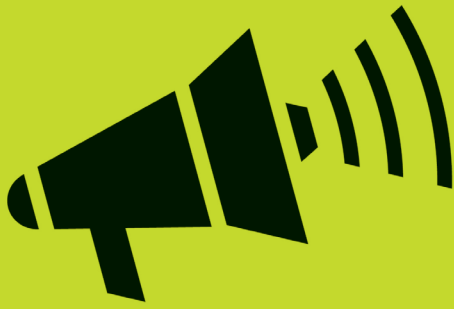




PUBLIC NOTICE: ROADWORKS IN SANDDRIFT

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate hereby advises the public of the construction of a raised pedestrian crossing in Sanddrift along Daniel Road. This will enhance pedestrian safety and encourage active mobility.

The work is planned to take place from Wednesday 26 August 2026 until Monday 5 October 2026 between 07:30 and 17:00, Monday to Fridays, weather permitting and provided there are no unforeseen delays. Residents can expect some noise during this time.

Please note that:

- The above-mentioned dates can change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected
- Flag personnel will direct traffic through temporary detours around the work area
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- Vehicles parked in the road and obstructing the maintenance work, will be moved or towed

Road users are urged to:

- Be cautious while work is underway
- Lower your speed
- Pay attention to road signs
- Be vigilant in and around the roadworks area
- Look out for uneven road surfaces
- Be mindful of the construction workers
- Factor in longer travel time

Congestion is expected, so it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

OPENBARE KENNISGEWING: PADWERKE IN SANDDRIFT

Die Stad Kaapstad se direktoraat stedelike mobiliteit stel hiermee die publiek in kennis van die aanbring van 'n verhoogde voetgangerkruising in Sanddrift in Danielweg. Dit sal voetgangerveiligheid bevorder en aktiewe mobiliteit aanmoedig.

Volgens beplanning sal die werk van Woensdag 26 Augustus 2026 tot Maandag 5 Oktober 2026 tussen 07:30 en 17:00 van Maandag tot Vrydag plaasvind, afhangende van die weer en indien geen onvoorsiene vertraging plaasvind nie. Inwoners kan geraas gedurende hierdie tydperk te wagte wees.

Let asseblief daarop dat:

- Die bogenoemde datums weens onvoorsiene omstandighede kan verander
- Verkeer in beide rigtings geraak sal word
- Vlagpersoneel die verkeer met tydelike ompaie rondom die werksgebied sal herlei
- Werksgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reguleer
- Voertuie wat in die pad geparkeer is en die werk belemmer, verskuif of weggesleep sal word

Padgebruikers word aangemoedig om:

- Versigtig te wees terwyl die werk aan die gang is
- Hul snelheid te verminder
- Aan padtekens aandag te gee
- Waaksaam binne en rondom die padwerkegebied te wees
- Op ongelyke padoppervlakke bedag te wees
- Konstruksiewerke in ag te neem
- Vir langer reistyd voorsiening te maak

Daar kan druk verkeer wees, en dus word padgebruikers aangeraai om alternatiewe roetes te oorweeg.
